

Peachtree Corners hires first City Clerk

The City of Peachtree Corners selected its first City Clerk on November 8, completing its roster of key staff members hired since its July 1 incorporation.

Kym Chereck, a 16-year resident of Chattahoochee Station subdivision in Peachtree Corners, was chosen from a number of valid candidates during a two-month process, announced Mayor Mike Mason.
