Residents to Head to Polls for First City-Held Referendum Vote *Alcohol Package Sales to be decided in November*

PEACHTREE CORNERS, GA, Sept. 18, 2014 – In the first city-wide vote to be held by the City of Peachtree Corners, residents will decide Nov. 4, 2014 on whether to allow alcohol package sales within city limits.

This is a municipal election which means voting will be held at Peachtree Corners City Hall, 147 Technology Parkway, Peachtree Corners, GA 30092. Voters will not use their usual polling places for county, state or federal elections to cast their votes for the city referendum.

“Only residents of the incorporated City of Peachtree Corners are eligible to vote,” said City Clerk Kym Chereck. “All residents who are registered voters may vote on the special referendum.”

Residents may cast their votes in several ways; Absentee Voting by Mail, Absentee Voting in Person (early voting), and on Election Day in person.

“Absentee/Early Voting in person will begin on Monday, Oct. 13 and will close the Friday before Election Day, Oct. 31,” said Chereck. Voting will be available weekdays during City Hall regular business hours: 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Voters must have proper identification to cast their votes. No absentee/early voting is permitted by law the Monday before Election Day. There will be no Saturday voting.

Absentee ballot applications are available on the city’s website www.peachtreecornersga.gov. Select the “Government” tab then choose “City Elections” in the pull down menu for voter information.

“I would like to encourage everyone to exercise their right to vote in the city’s first municipal election,” said Mayor Mike Mason. “Please remember City Hall will be the polling location for

this referendum vote.” City Council approved adding the referendum to the ballot at its Sept. 16, 2014 City Council meeting.

Voter information is posted on the City of Peachtree Corners website, www.peachtreecornersga.gov. Locate the “Government” tab at the top of the homepage and click on “City Elections” in the pull-down menu for more on voter registration, voting in city elections, where to vote, elections notices and absentee ballots by mail.
