Rachel Watters has been a dedicated obstacle course racer since 2015, earning over 30 career Elite Spartan Race podiums and more than 25 top finishes at Savage Race, as well as podium placements at a variety of other OCR and fitness events.

Rachel finished in the top five at the Spartan Ultra World Championships and 24-Hour World's Toughest Mudder and is also a three-time "Wall of Champion" honoree at the Peachtree Corners Decathlon at Fort Pain.

In 2025, Rachel proudly represents the USA Obstacle Course Racing (USAOCR) National Team. Her accomplishments have earned her community recognition, including runner-up honors for both "Best Female OCR Athlete" and "Best Female Hybrid Athlete" in the 2024 OCR Buddy Community Choice Awards.

Rachel is also passionate about giving back—she serves as a board member for Lionhearts Fitness, a nonprofit that provides free OCR training and racing opportunities to at-risk youth.
