The purpose of this addendum is to present the following changes as well as provide the answers to the written questions received during the question-and-answer period of the RFQ as follows:

I. Written Questions and Answers:

	Questions	Answers
1.	Our questions are to what extent is Confluence involved in this project and will they be making the decision on the company selected to produce the sign.	Confluence developed the concepts that are included in the RFQ, but they will not be involved in this project going forward.
2.	Are we responsible for providing electrical to the sign? If so, where is the electrical intended to be run from?	This is a Design-Build and electrical infrastructure will be included in the design portion of this project.
3.	Is this project tax-exempt?	The City has tax-exempt status
4.	How would the City prefer that we conceal the wiring for the illuminated peaches?	This procurement is for a Design-Build, which means the design has not yet been completed. The drawings included in this RFQ are for the purpose of everyone seeing the design intent, but final design details will be completed by the selected vendor.
5.	Would the existing solar panels and associated pole/structure be required to be relocated as part of this project? If relocation is required, would the General Contractor (GC) be responsible for all aspects of the relocation (including disconnection, removal, reinstallation, testing, and any necessary permitting or coordination with utility providers)?	This is a design-build procurement process, which involves selecting a contractor first, then the design details will be completed by the selected contractor. Design details are not available at this time.
6.	Please provide details on the location and specifications of the existing or proposed power supply serving the sign (e.g., nearest electrical panel, utility meter, voltage/amperage available, conduit routing, or any existing solar integration). Is the sign intended to be powered solely by grid electricity, solar (existing or new), or a hybrid system? Any available as-built drawings, electrical single-line diagrams, or site utility plans would be greatly appreciated.	Design details are not available at this time.
7.	Would a dedicated light/switch panel (or lighting control panel) be required for sign illumination or related features? If required, please specify the preferred or required location (e.g., at the base of the sign structure, in a nearby utility room, at a central city control point, or integrated into an existing panel). Any details on control method (timer, photocell, smart controls, or remote access) would also be helpful.	Design details are not available at this time.
8.	For the freestanding letters spelling "CENTER": Are these intended to be individual free-standing letters mounted directly to grade/paving without a separate foundation, or will they require a dedicated concrete footing/pad for structural support? If a footing is required, please provide any known specifications. Any site-specific geotechnical data, soil reports, or foundation details from prior signage installations would be beneficial.	Design details are not available at this time.
