Pursuant to the action taken on this date, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Peachtree Corners, I am authorized to request that you as the representative for Gwinnett County, Georgia, initiate a moratorium for 90 days on all matters enumerated in this correspondence, from this point forward, as may be presented to Gwinnett County and that occur within the confines of the City of Peachtree Corners.

This moratorium includes:

1. All zoning and land use matters
2. Alcohol permits
3. Business licenses
4. Massage parlor licenses
5. Taxi cab permits
6. Adult entertainment establishment licenses
7. Adult bookstore licenses
8. Sign and billboard permits
9. Building and demolition permits

I am further authorized to notify you, as the representative for Gwinnett County, Georgia, that the City of Peachtree Corners, Georgia, intends to take the above stated nine functions as of midnight June 30, 2012, upon the passage of concurrent resolutions when required by the Peachtree Corners Charter.

It is the intent of the City of Peachtree Corners for Gwinnett County, Georgia, to continue to collect all fines, fees and taxes and other monies as contemplated by the City Charter.
