Plans and Specifications Dated: 1/29/19

This Addendum is to confirm to all Bidders and other interested parties the following information relating to the PTC 17.05 Advanced Vehicle Lanes Project.

1. Bid Form Article 5 Basis of Bid - Add "Alternate Bid #4 – Utility Conduit, see attached for revisions.
2. Bid Form Article 9 Bid Submittal, see attached for revisions.
3. Contractor to provide all costs associated with Alternate Bid #4 Conduit Installation. Alternate Bid #4 costs will be based on written description of work and quantities provided in attached.

Description of work is as follows:

Contractor to provide a cost to supply and install three runs of conduit. They shall be installed along the corridor within the ROW associated with Technology Parkway. A SUE Level B Survey and construction drawings are ongoing and will be provided to the contractor at completion. The three conduit runs shall consist of the following.

- Conduit 1 consists of 7,500 l.f. nonmetal, TP 2, 4-inch conduit with (3) 1 ¼-inch, HDPE innerducts.
- Conduit 2 consists of 2,800 l.f. of nonmetal, TP 2, 4-inch conduit, 2,260 l.f. of nonmetal, TP 2, 3-inch conduit and 2,440 l.f. of nonmetal, TP 2, 2-inch conduit.
- Conduit 3 consists of 2,800 l.f. of nonmetal, TP 2, 4-inch conduit, 2,260 l.f. of nonmetal, TP 2, 3-inch conduit and 2,440 l.f. of nonmetal, TP 2, 2-inch conduit.

All Conduit shall be installed to a min dept of 48". Contractor to include (23) 12x12 Pull Boxes at locations to be determined. All conduit to include conduit detection wire and pull lines.
