1. **Roll Call** – Mayor and all Council present.
2. **Discussion on Face Mask** – The Mayor and Council discussed a Mask Ordinance for the City of Peachtree Corners. This item will move forward to the July 28, 2020 Council Meeting.
3. **Zoning Presentation** – Dave Rhodes, City Attorney, gave a presentation on Ethics in Zoning. Topics included conflicts of interest in rezoning actions, fraud or corruption in rezoning actions, and ex parte communications.
4. **Discussion on Wine Bars** – Brandon Branham, Assistant City Manager, informed the Mayor and Council of an amendment to the Alcohol Ordinance to include wine bars. This item will move forward to the July 28, 2020 Council Meeting.
5. **FY 2021 Street Resurfacing** – Greg Ramsey, Public Works Director, presented the Mayor and Council with the FY 2021 resurfacing street list. After discussion it was determined that Scientific Drive and Technology Parkway South would include a shared bike lane, and Westech Drive would include a separate bike lane.
6. **Curiosity Lab Authorization** – Brandon Branham, Assistant City Manager, informed the Mayor and Council that there will be a Resolution at the next Council meeting for the City Manager to approve projects which further develop the Curiosity Lab at Peachtree Corners. This item will move forward to the July 28, 2020 Council Meeting.
7. **Census Update** – Jeff Conkle, Planning and Zoning Administrator, presented the Mayor and Council with an update of what the city staff and Peachtree Corners Census Committee have done to try to increase the response rates to the Census.
